

This is the privacy notice of W.S.D.A. The Seadragons registered at Bornsesteeg 2, 6708 PE Wageningen. We value the protection of your personal data. In this privacy notice we want to provide clear and transparent information about how we process personal data.

Our association is responsible for handling any privacy sensitive data according to law including the Algemene Verordening Gegevensbescherming (AVG). If you have any questions regarding these regulations, please do not hesitate to contact us: [the.seadragons@wur.nl](mailto:the.seadragons@wur.nl).

1. We are only using your personal data if you register as a member or share personal information with us.
2. The information is used to keep in contact about relevant matters and to enable our services to you.
3. Only board members can access all personal data. Committee members have access to relevant email addresses and information given upon registering for an event.
4. The information is stored as long as there is a reason to keep it (regular contact, membership etc.). Upon termination of contact, the information will be deleted within 6 months.
5. Pictures are stored for an unlimited period. If you participate in an activity, you give consent to use of the pictures. If you would like us to delete a specific picture, please send us an email.
6. The information is not shared with third parties unless you have agreed to this or it necessary to enable the service the data was provided for. If you are registered as a diving member, your data will be shared with the Nederlandse Onderwatersportbond (NOB) in order to register you in the association and provide insurance. With this association we share name, email address, address, date of birth, phone number and NOB registration number and emergency contact if applicable. We furthermore reserve the right to share relevant information with SWU Thymos and sports centre De Bongerd.
7. You have a number of rights regarding the processing of personal data:
  - a. You have the right of access to your personal data (article 15 GDPR). If you want to know which of your personal data we process, you can submit a written request to obtain access.
  - b. You have the right to rectification of your personal data (article 16 GDPR). If your data are incorrect, incomplete or irrelevant, you can submit a request to have your data corrected or completed.
  - c. You have the right to erasure (article 17 GDPR). In certain cases, you can request that we remove the data we received from you.
  - d. You have the right to restriction of processing (article 18 GDPR). In certain cases, we are not allowed to remove your data yet, but you can ask us not to process them anymore.
  - e. You have the right to data portability (article 20 GDPR). You have the right to have your data transmitted from us to you or, in your name, directly to another party.
  - f. You have the right to object (article 21 GDPR). You can object to the processing of your personal data (or a part of them) by us or one of our processors. We will then cease processing your data.
8. Our website and association are not targeting people younger than 16 years old and we assume we do not collect their information. If you discover that this has been the case nevertheless, please contact us and we will delete the data immediately.
9. You have the right to file a complaint at the respective supervisory authority. However, we would appreciate if you would contact us first.
10. Our website uses cookies. A cookie is a small file that is saved on your device upon accessing a website. When visiting the website, you can adjust which cookies we are allowed place on your device. Essential cookies are always enabled, you additionally have the option to retract

your consent for us to use analytical, functional and marketing cookies. You can always adjust these setting in your browser settings later on.
